China Development Forum 2024 The Continuous Development of China

Opening Ceremony

The China Development Forum (CDF) 2024 kicks off in Beijing on March 24. Li Qiang, member of the Standing Committee of the Political Bureau of the CPC Central Committee and premier of the State Council, attended the opening ceremony and delivered a keynote speech. State Councilor and Secretary-General of the State Council Wu Zhenglong attended the opening ceremony. Chair of the CDF 2024 Lu Hao, also the director of the Development Research Centre of the State Council, presided over the opening ceremony. Co-Chair of the CDF 2024 Evan Greenberg, also the chairman and CEO of Chubb Group, delivered a speech at the opening ceremony.

He said that the Chinese and world economies are highly integrated today. Continuous efforts will be made to foster a world-class business environment that is market-oriented, law-based and internationalized, steadily advance institutional opening up and link with the world at a higher level of openness. A more open China will definitely bring more opportunities for win-win cooperation to the world. China is ready to share with the world the great opportunities of China's sustained development and work with all parties to create a bright future of common development.

Evan Greenberg expressed in his speech that China has a large pool of high-quality labor, well-developed infrastructure, and strong manufacturing and technological capabilities. A vibrant private sector will drive investment expansion, job creation, and boost confidence in innovation, thus helping attract foreign investors. A robust and thriving China that supports and invests in the global system represents a positive force on the world stage.
